## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### DURATION

This qualification is typically delivered over a minimum duration of 6 -12 months, including 120 hours of work placement in an aged care and disability setting.

### DELIVERY

The training is conducted by a qualified, industry current, trainer and assessor to ensure the learning is relevant and up to date. This training will take place in a classroom environment using face-to-face training methods at one of our study locations. Intakes are scheduled throughout the year.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, although applicants will need to undertake an LLN assessment. Students are required to complete a Practical Placement which requires a police check and a NDIS screening. Students must also have current COVID-19 vaccinations.

### FURTHER STUDY OPTIONS

Upon completion, students could go further with their study with our CHC43015 - Certificate IV in Ageing Support and CHC43121 - Certificate IV in Disability.
